- Describe each session of the SFST School in terms of the Domains of Learning and the Four-Step Process.

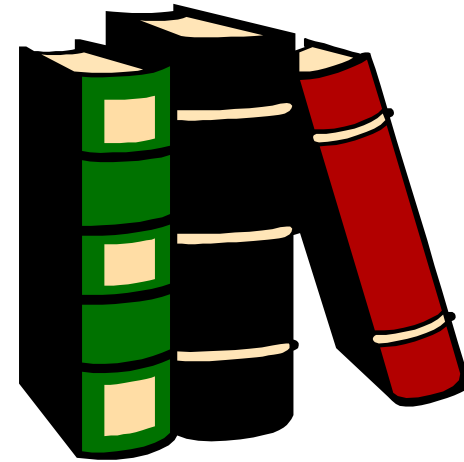

- Amount of time to be spent on the topic.
- Audio-visual aids to be used.
- Questions to be posed to stimulate participation.
- Procedures for classroom learning activities.
- Indications of points to be emphasized.
